

What You Can Do To Say No To Slickwater Hydraulic Fracking

1. Share *Don't Frack Michigan's* educational materials with others.
2. Write or call respected environmental and conservation advocates and your representatives. Tell them we must move beyond fossil fuels. Inform them that they must demand the EPA and DOE close the Hydraulic Fracturing exemptions and loopholes to the *Clean Water Act, Safe Drinking Water Act, Clean Air Act, National Environmental Policy Act, Emergency Planning and Community Right to Know Act and Resource Conservation and Recovery Act*. Demand an end to Fossil Fuel Subsidies. When the planning field is leveled, Safe Renewable Energy Resources (Wind, Solar, Conservation and Energy Efficiency) can compete successfully.
